FACTS FOUND

At 2100hrs on 18th November FRA9 checked the official noticeboard and was in 25th place.

FRA9 saw the results online on the morning of 19th November which indicated he was in 26th place. He then came to the club to check the official notice board afterwhich he submitted a request for redress.

Before the redress decision of Case 11 was applied FRA9 was in 25th place, after the redress was applied FRA9 was in 26th place.

In 25th place FRA9 would have been in the Gold fleet, in 26th place FRA9 is in the silver fleet.
