### 49er

The 49er fleet will be divided into two fleets (after racing on Sunday) – a gold fleet and a silver fleet: The 25 best boats will go to the gold fleet and the rest of the boats will go to the silver fleet.

On Monday 30 June the gold fleet and the silver fleet will sail three races each.

On Tuesday 1 July the gold fleet and the silver fleet will sail two races each.

After the two races in the gold fleet, the top 10 boats will sail in the medal race series. Three races are scheduled in the medal race series.

### 49erFX

On Monday 30 June the 49erFX will race up to three races in one fleet in a qualifying series.

On Tuesday 1 July the 49erFX will race up to two races in one fleet in a qualifying series.

After the two races, the top 10 boats (only 49erFX girls) will sail in the medal race series. Three races are scheduled in the medal race series.

## **49er and 49erFX Medal races – target time, time limit and starting procedure:**

The target sailing time for the medal races is 10 minutes. The time limit is 20 minutes. Boats failing to finish within 5 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored DNF without a hearing.

This changes S.I. 16.1 and rules 35, A4 and A5.

The starting procedure will be:

5 minutes before start:	Attention signal	Orange flag up (one sound)
3 minutes before start:	Warning signal	Class flag up (one sound)
2 minutes before start:	Preparatory signal	P flag up (one sound)
1 minute before start:	One minute	P flag down (one sound)
0:	Start	Class flag down (one sound)

(This changes rule 26)
