Pre Event Class Rule Compliance Inspection and Timetable

Class rule compliance inspection for all teams competing in the International 49er Class 2015 World Championship shall commence:

Friday	13 November	1000 to	1800	
Saturday	14 November	0900 to	1800	
Sunday	15 November	0900 to	1100	IF REOUIRED

PLEASE NOTE: No team shall be considered for Pre Event measurement until the event entry fee has been paid in full and the Equipment Declaration Form has been completed where required by the team (Serial Numbers).

All teams are reminded that Mainsails shall be presented with the correct Country flag, country code and sail number in place.

Hulls **shall** be dry and drained of any internal water. Failure to comply will see the offending hull quarantined until such time its dryness satisfies the inspection team.

Sail numbers shall be that of the ISAF hull plaque, Personal number or last World Championship top 10 placing. Incorrect identification (sail number) will **NOT** be event approved.

All competitors are reminded that in accordance with RRS 78.1 you are responsible for ensuring that your equipment is maintained in accordance with the current class rules.

In particular equipment requiring a 9er Certified Equipment sticker as in accordance with the International 49er/ FX class rules shall do so.

Remember - Blank forms will not be accepted meaning that a team will be relegated to the end of the timetable.

Note: the gennaker pole sticker can be found on the inside of the spar at the aft end.

Note: please ensure your boat complies with the latest class rule relating to hull weight (Equipment on/off)

Note: top mast shall have a stopper as fitted by the manufacturer in the first instance.

Pre Event inspection shall be by Country and shall be for both 49er and 49erFX.
