RACING AREA: Courses will be sailed on the Inner Flensburg

Fiord within max. 2,5 nm distance to the yacht

harbor Glücksburg-Quellental.

RACE OFFICE: The Race Office will be located inside the

clubhouse of Flensburger Segel-Club at Glücksburg. During the Championships it will

open daily at 9:00 hrs.

CLASSES: 49er, 49erFX

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

- 1.2 RRS Appendix P, Immediate Penalties for breaking Rule 42, will apply
- 1.3 For the Final Races, ISAF Addendum Q (as posted on the official notice board) takes precedence over any conflicting instructions.
- 1.4 The Class and Championship Rules of the International 49er and 49erFX Class Association will apply except for any that are altered by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions
- 1.5 No National Authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Competitors shall comply with ISAF Eligibility Rules.
- 3.2 All competitors shall be under 24 on 31st December 2015.
- 3.3 All competitors shall be fully paid-up members of the International 49er Class Association.
- 3.4 Entries should be received by the Organizing Authority no later than 23. July 2015.

- 3.6 No entry is complete until it has been accepted by the Organizing Authority and the International 49er Class Association and the entry fee has been paid in full.
- 3.6 Each participating boat shall be registered and measured before the first warning signal of the event.

4. FEES

Entry Fee: € 190.00 (until 23. July 2015), € 250.00 (after 24.July 2015) includes the International Class Championship Fee.

Entry fees will only be refunded if the entry is rejected.

5. FORMAT OF RACING

- 5.1 The Championship will consist of an Opening Series and a Medal Race. The Opening Series will be divided into a Qualifying Series and a Final Series.
- 5.2 The Medal Race will be of the standard ISAF Medal Race format.

6. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

6.2 On Thursday 27. August there will be no warning signal after 1700.

7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 All boats will be inspected for class rules compliance prior to racing, according to the Schedule of Events. Additional spot measurement checks may be carried out during the Championship.
- 7.2 Only one set of sails and one forestay shall be used throughout the duration of the Championship.
- 7.3 Equipment shall only be replaced with permission of the Race Committee.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

9. VENUE

The 2015 49er/49erFX Junior World Championship will be held at Flensburger Segel-Club, Quellental, D-24960 Glücksburg, Germany.

10. THE COURSES

Courses will be windward/leeward with a gate at the leeward end of the course.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by a One-Turn penalty.

12. SCORING

- 12.1 The Low Points Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 12.2 At least four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute the Championship. When four or more Opening Series races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 12.3. The scoring system will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

13. SUPPORT BOATS

13.1 Support boats shall be registered with the Organizing Authority and will be required to comply with local legislation and event support boat regulations. Team leaders/coaches shall register at:

and complete on-site a registration form at the race office at the venue. The fee for support boat registration shall be € 25.00

- 13.2 All support boats shall clearly display the 3 letter national code of their ISAF Member National Authority at all times while afloat. The minimum height for the letters shall be 200mm.
- 13.3 If called upon support boats will be required to act as rescue boats.

14. INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS 91(b). Its decisions will be final as provided in RRS 70.5

15. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the first six boats in the boys 49er Championship and the first six boats in the girls 49erFX Championship.

16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions, text messages or cellular phone calls while racing.

17. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of at least EUR 1,500,000 (or equivalent) per incident.

18. RISK STATEMENT

RRS 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.'

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extend caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particular in extreme weather conditions, as can practically provided in the circumstances:
- g) All participants are required to sign a liability waiver upon registration. Its wording is available as addition to the NoR.

19. MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

- 19.1 By participating in the Championship competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority, International 49er Class Association and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of competition without compensation.
- 19.2 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority.
- 19.3 Competitors may also use their own camera recording equipment and attachments, but these are to be removable for weighing.
- 19.4 Competitors may be required for interviews and press conferences at the Championship.
