#### SYNOPSIS today 04 UTC (06:00 LT) and development:

- Low pressure determines the big picture the whole day through
- Center of the low is W of Scotland this morning...low is slowly moving E into the North Sea. Low will arrive over SW Norway tomorrow, Friday, midday
- Associated fronts are first the warm front. We are positioned ahead of it theses morning hours...long lasting rain belongs to this front. The warm front will clear us later morning between 10 and 11 LT
- cold front is following...it will clear us early afternoon between 14 and 15 LT
- morning session still seeing stable conditions in a building gradient
- cold front will fill in with much more unstability accompanied of heavier showers with a weak probability of thunderstorms within theses showers
- late afternoon drier air is filling in to clear the sky more consequently
- wind is mainly gradient wind today...gradient is slowly building through the day
- with the colder air from early afternoon on gustiness is a big issue

#### **TODAY**

#### WIND:

- Morning session sees mainly gradient wind
- Rain is easing the breeze temporary a little bit....basically there is very good pressure from the S we are starting into
- Wind will go from early TWD 180° to the right into 230° (240°) late afternoon
- Fronts will offer more sudden changes in the wind dir
- There is still a slow build within the average breeze through the day
- Main remarkable change in the gustiness to become much stronger in the afternoon
- More cumulus likely clouds from midday and through the afternoon will have stronger influence onto local TWD and TWS with higher variability in both

#### GUSTS:

Gusting is increasing through the day. Morning / Midday see gusts HOTEL up to 22 kts, other courses 25 kts. Afternoon increasing HOTEL 24 kts, outer courses 28 – 31 kts.

#### **WARNINGS:**

Weak risk of thunderstorms (10 % probability) within the rain showers and gusts of ~35 kts

#### **WEATHER:**

Longer lasting rain still through the morning. 10 - 11 LT sees some interruption in the rain with shortly some clearing followed by new showers from the W. After 17 LT most showers are disappearing with the sun still coming out for the evening. Still 2 - 3 hours of sun this evening.

**TEMPERATURES**: Air: 21°C (over land) 20° C (over water) SST: 19°C

#### Friday, 05/08/2017

Today's low pressure system is still positioned over the North Sea and will stay there most of the day. We are on the S side of the low in a strong SW-ly flow with a strong gradient. Very gusty.

Often change of many clouds with showers to sunny periods.
