## International 49er Class Association 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of the World Council

The 25<sup>th</sup> annual meeting of the World Council of the International 49er Class Association was held remotely by video conference call, on 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 and in person in Mussanah, Oman. The meeting started at 2000 hours Oman time.
