



INSPECTION TIMETABLE

Pre-event Class Rules compliance

Class Rules compliance inspection for all Teams competing in the International NACRA 17 Class 2022 European Championship shall commence:

Friday 1st of July 2022 09:00am to 06:00pm

Note: no Team shall be considered for pre-event measurement until the event entry fee has been paid in full and the Equipment Limitation Form has been completed where required by the Team.

All Teams are reminded that Mainsails shall be presented with the correct Country Code and Sail Number in place.

Hulls shall be dry and drained of any internal water. Failure to comply will see offending teams hull quarantined until such time its dryness satisfies the inspection team. Teams are reminded that tillers are also to be water free.

Sail numbers shall be that of the World Sailing (ISAF) hull plaque. Any helm or crew ever having placed in the top 25 at a NACRA 17 Class World Championship or having competed at the most recent Olympic Games shall use an IN17CA issued personal sail number between 1 - 99. Helms having raced at the previous Olympic Games, may use the number corresponding with their Olympic finish. Incorrect identification (Sail Number) will not be event approved.

All competitors are reminded that in accordance with RRS 78.1 you are responsible for ensuring that your equipment is maintained in accordance with the current Class Rules. In particular equipment requiring a NACRA Certified Equipment sticker as in accordance with the International NACRA 17 Class Rules shall do so. Should a sticker have been lost and or damaged please mark form accordingly.

Remember - Blank forms will not be accepted meaning that a team will be relegated to the end of the timetable.

Note: please ensure your boat complies with the enforce Class Rules.

Pre-event inspection shall be by Country and the Team being inspected and or coach/manager shall only be permitted in the measurement area throughout the pre-event period.

Items to be pre-event inspected and event certified:

- **Hull weight** Shall be clean and dry
- **Forestay length** Shall be measured and event tagged
- **Mainsail, Jib, Spinnaker** Shall be visually checked ID and number
- **Event stickers** Shall be visually checked
