What should I bear in mind at my arrival at the Galician Sailing Center?



- · The opening of the entrance barrier for vehicles will be activated only and exclusively with the QR code provided at the end of this document. It will be the same code that will open the coaches' pontoon. WATCH OUT! It is important to use this code and not to ring the bell!
- · In order to facilitate the unloading of boats and RIBs the day of your arrival at the Galician Sailing Center, you must follow the following steps:

Once you have entered the venue, you must unload your boat(s) in the boat park and contact the staff if you wish to unload a RIB.

The organisation will take the trailers away and store them until the last racing day. That day, they will be brought back to the same loading and unloading area. In the event of needing access to the trailer, it must be requested at the race office.

· The unloading and loading of RIBs will take place at the ramp on the left and after that it must be moored at the corresponding pontoon (#5 on the map).









What should I bear in mind at my arrival at the Galician Sailing Center?

· Vans must be parked <u>only and exclusively</u> in the areas designated for this purpose (green areas on the map). They must never interrupt road traffic or access to the warehouses.

· The closest petrol station is located in Vilaxoán.

Sailors parade, Opening Ceremony & Village

· The Opening Ceremony will be held on Tuesday the 16th at 18h00. We will meet at 17h45 at the entrance of the Galicia Sailing Center, where each team must be ready with their national flag (teams are asked to bring themselves their corresponding flag). Teams will parade from there to Galicia Square ('Plaza de Galicia'), where there will be an official reception.



- · The race village (#2 on the map) will be open daily from the first racing day on.
- \cdot Crew Dinner for all competitors and coaches will be from the 16th to the 20th (both days included) at at 20h00.
- · Refreshments (fruit and bars) will be provided for the sailors daily. There will also be water fountains. Please, remind to bring your own bottle to fill it.









Race areas and in/out from the marina

- · To access the race area Bravo, there are two options:
- 1- Passage between islands: right through the middle, between the buoys on either side of the channel.
- 2- Passage through the mussels rafts area: it is easier than the inter-island passage, go as close to the mussels rafts as possible.

Bear in mind that the passage between islands is shallow when the tide is low, so it is important to keep an eye on the buoys that mark the passage area.











· For security reasons, when entering and leaving the port, it is compulsory to respect the exclusion areas indicated on the map:



Prizes

- · Trophies will be awarded for the first five places overall of each class.
- · The Diputación de Pontevedra Trophy will be awarded to the Best Country in the 49er class.
- · The Xunta de Galicia Trophy will be awarded to the Best Country in the 49er FX class.
- · The Concello de Vilagarcía Trophy will be awarded to the Best Country in the Nacra 17 class.
- · To decide the winning country for each trophy, the positions of the first two boats of the same country shall be taken and added together; the country with the fewest points shall be the champion. If a country is represented by only one team, the second boat score will be the result of the position of the last classified boat + 1.
